 - Meet the School Team:
 - · All school leaders from Movement Schools are in Charlotte for training
 - Bobby Miles Founding Principal:
 - 17th year in education
 - Started in Charlotte teaching Science; moved to Nashville in 2018 where he was an assistant principal and principal for 3 years each
 - Alexandra Graham Office/Business Manager:
 - From Charleston; has worked in multiple schools over her career
 - Sees what Movement is doing in Charlotte and knows it is needed in Charleston
- Enrollment update:
 - Kindergarten: 113 applications; 1 offered; 86 accepted; 11 started registrations; 35 fully registered; 26 declines
 - First Grade: 107 applications; 3 offered; 72 accepted; 3 started registration; 23 fully registered; 32 declines
 - Increase from numbers reported last meeting positive
 - Consistent concerns:
 - School construction they can't see the finished product yet
 - Documentation immunizations and wellness checks; they want to have all of these done before finalizing registrations
 - Registrations in Charleston are normally done in late July, so many simply are not used to the early registration request
 - Families aren't necessarily declining, just do not have a sense of urgency
 - Our urgency centers on wanting students and families at onboarding activities. These are important and we want families to participate.
 - Home visits are going well
 - Building update:
 - On track/potentially slightly ahead of schedule
 - There is an issue with a turning lane. This needs to be ironed out to get our CO.
 - Back to School Night on July 25 hope to be ready by then
 - Orientation for families:
 - Tuesday, June 18
 - Also have two Saturday options

- Child Nutrition:
